Fall Staff Contracts - Guest Services Ministries

Compensation: \$150-250/week, plus room & board

IAWAH seeks fall contract staff to serve within the Food Services, Hosting, Housekeeping, and Facility teams facilitating retreats and conferences. These positions are ideal for young adults who are interested in serving within a Christian context while gaining work experience and skills within the service industry.

Fall Staff members fill a variety of roles while at IAWAH including:

- Food Service: preparing and serving food, doing dishes, working with call-in staff & volunteers. Working towards independence in the kitchen, leading kitchen shifts when ready
- Housekeeping: preparing the site for guests through a high attention to detail in cleaning.
- Facilities (work projects): working alongside our facility team in a variety of fall projects.
- Group Hosting and/or Activity Instructors: teaching students outdoors skills, canoeing, facilitating team challenge, belaying on the climbing wall, or other activities.

Training, as necessary, is provided.

Time allocation: Depending on specific contract. Generally, within Food Services, Maintenance & Housekeeping: 65-75%; Within Hosting or Activity leading and other roles 25-35 %

The successful applicants will have:

- the ability to function successfully in a fast paced, multi-tasking, and high learning environment;
- the ability to self manage
- demonstrated the ability to learn in a team context;
- signed IAWAH's Staff Expectations and Contract
- an acceptable reference and background check, including Police Records Check and vulnerable sector check.

In addition, the following will be considered assets:

- previous successful experience in the primary role being considered;
- Food Service experience, NLS, Climbing Instructor, Hospitality experience
