Prerequisites:

The successful candidate must be responsible, flexible and relatable. Prior experience with childcare, previous experience with camping ministry and Standard First Aid with CPR "C" will be considered assets.

Overview:

As a cabin leader, you are on the front lines of the camper experience and play an integral role in the quality of each camper's stay. Your job is to connect with each of your campers individually as well as build community as a cabin group demonstrating God's love to them. Cabin leaders are scheduled to teach 2 activity periods each day. Please indicate in your application which activity areas you would most like to serve in.

Expectations:

1. Stay in the cabins with the campers and supervise overnight experience.
2. Be an example of Christ to all campers
3. Participate in daily activities with campers including meals, games, and rest time.
4. Jr. Camp Cabin Staff rotate through activities with cabin group.
5. Lead / teach assigned activities.
6. Create a welcoming, accepting, safe environment for campers.
7. Ensure that all campers have their needs met and are being cared for appropriately.
8. Bring any personal or camper concerns to your Don or Camping Coordinator.
