Prerequisites:

The successful candidates must have the ability to function successfully in a fast paced, multitasking, and high learning environment. They must demonstrate the ability to facilitate activities which engage children relationally, creatively and effectively, while demonstrating the ability to work in a team context. Current Standard First Aid and CPR "C", wilderness first aid certification, NLS certifications, ORCKA certifications and Challenge Course Facilitator Certifications will all be seen as assets. Preference will be given to individuals considering summer camping positions. Training will be provided.

Overview:

Camp IAWAH Spring Staff to serve in its spring, school group, season. These positions are ideal for postsecondary students interested in serving in a Christian context while gaining experience and skills in the outdoor recreation field. Under the direction of the Spring Coordinator, the successful candidates will be able to effectively engage and relate students during our school group season (late spring) in a recreation setting, creatively teach new skills and activities, and facilitate activity based small group learning.

Expectations:

- 1. Serve guest groups by welcoming guests, organizing logistics, acting as MC for meals, implement and troubleshoot schedules, housekeeping duties.
- 2. Preparing and serving food, doing dishes, and general housekeeping.
- 3. Be open and flexible to participate in each spring team role as required. This will also include facility work on property.
- 4. Enthusiastically teach and lead students in all activity areas offered at camp. Facilitate learning experiences and develop teamwork skills within student using low ropes and group initiative tasks.
- 5. Join in weekly cleaning and preparation of buildings and facilities.

In addition to the above expectations, the successful candidate will contribute positively to an environment where we seek to encourage, build up and humbly challenge one another to continually grow. As a leader, they will demonstrate discernment and maturity helping to perpetuate safety, efficiency and fun as we strive to create a place for campers as well as staff from many different walks of life to be able to open up and experience freedom in a life with Christ.
