Prerequisite:

Overview:

Camp IAWAH seeks Fall Staff to serve in its fall Retreats season. These positions are ideal for postsecondary students interested in serving in a Christian context while gaining experience and skills in the outdoor recreation field. Under the direction of the Fall Team Leader, the successful candidates will be able to effectively engage students and adults in a recreation setting, creatively teach new skills and activities, and facilitate activity based small group learning, as well as serve in the kitchen as well as maintenance.

Specific roles* within the fall staff team include:

Hosting:

Serving guest groups by welcoming guests, organizing logistics, acting as MC for meals, implementing and troubleshooting schedules, housekeeping duties;

Food Service and Housekeeping :

Preparing and serving food, doing dishes, and general housekeeping.

Activity Instructors / Belayers / Challenge Course Facilitators:

Teaching students camp and outdoor skills, belaying, facilitating learning experiences using low ropes and group initiative tasks.

*Although you may be assigned a primary role as per the above descriptions, all fall staff can be expected to participate in each role as required. This will also include facility work on property.

Training, as necessary, is provided.

The successful candidates will have:

- the ability to function successfully in a fast paced, multitasking, and high learning environment;
- demonstrated the ability to learn in a team context;
- current Standard First Aid and CPR "C" and/or wilderness first aid certification.

In addition, the following will be considered assets:

- previous successful experience in the primary role being considered;
- Challenge Course Facilitator Certification, Climbing Instructor;

The successful candidate will contribute positively to an environment where we seek to encourage, build up and humbly challenge one another to continually grow. As a leader, they will demonstrate discernment and maturity helping to perpetuate safety, efficiency and fun.

All staff are required to sign IAWAH's Staff Expectations, which will be provided upon receiving a contract.
